other times there was one only.

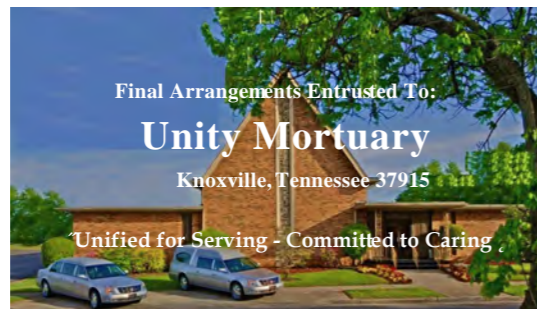
This bothered me because I noticed that during the
