other times there was one only.*

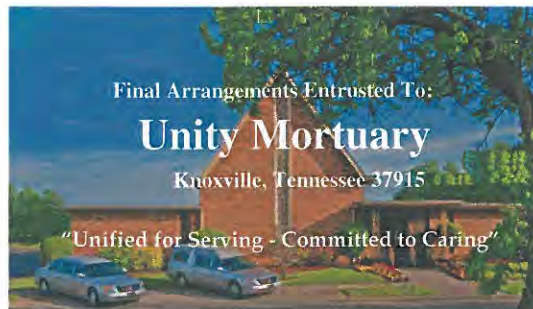
*This bothered me because I noticed that during the
